Abstract

Keith Godard (1938-2020) was a renowned designer of public art and exhibitions, and a pioneer of the teaching of graphic design history. He was the Principal of StudioWorks and a faculty member in SVA's MFA Design department. The Godard Collection represents his exuberantly textural and conceptual approach to design.
